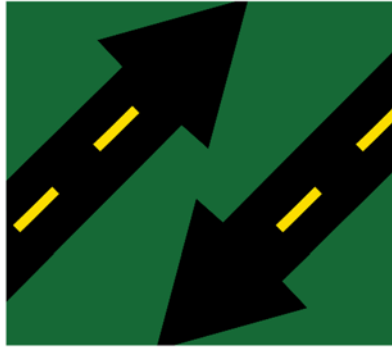

Please note: This information is subject to change. Projects, road closures and timing can change from day to day, depending upon a number of factors, and traffic delays can develop in a matter of minutes due to weather conditions, emergency situations, etc.

Schoolcraft Township

Road: U Avenue - Oakland Drive to Portage Road
Current Status: Fine grading the week of 5/3/21
Detour: Road closed to through traffic during the project. The detour route is Portage Road, W Avenue, and US-131.
Project Information: This project includes reconstructing U Avenue from Portage Road to Oakland Drive with superelevation correction in the curves. Work will also occur on Portage Road at U Avenue to widen and resurface for a north/south left turn lane.
Start Date: March 22, 2021
End Date: June 25, 2021

County Wide Projects

Road: Systemic Signs Upgrade
Current Status: Sign upgrades occurring in Richland and Comstock Townships.
Detour: No detours or closures.
Project Information: This project includes upgraded installations at stop signs in the northern half of the county. Upgraded stop signs will feature larger signs with reflective sheeting on sign posts for additional emphasis at Primary Road intersections.
Start Date: March 18, 2021
End Date: June 1, 2021

Road: Crack filling on various roads in Kalamazoo County
Current Status: Crack Fill continues; week of 5/3/21, Comstock, Charleston, and Ross Townships
Detour: Traffic to be maintained during project. Temporary traffic regulators may be necessary.
Project Information: Crack Filling
Start Date: April 19, 2021
End Date: Mid-December

Road: Hot Mix Asphalt Wedging on various roads in Kalamazoo County
Current Status: Wedging began the week of 4/26/21 starting in Charleston Township and progressing counterclockwise throughout the county
Detour: Traffic to be maintained during project. Temporary traffic regulators may be necessary.
Project Information: Wedging

Start Date: April 26, 2021
End Date: Mid-October
